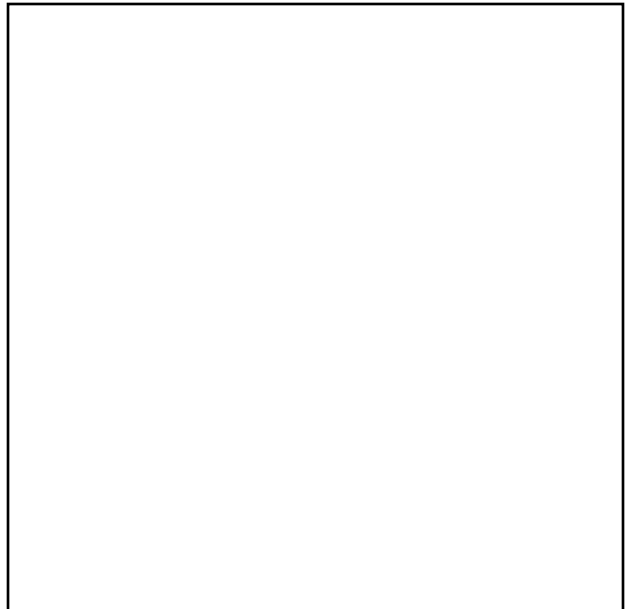

PUPPY PURCHASE AGREEMENT

Basic Puppy Care Agreement and Health Guarantee

Breeder guarantees the above described dog to be in good health, to the best of our knowledge at the time of sale. All appropriate vaccinations for the puppy's age have been given and a record of this will be supplied. The puppy comes with the following: CKC registration, 1st vaccination, micro-chipped, life-time support and a 1 year health guarantee from date of birth.

Breeder must be notified at the time of or prior to any change in address or phone number of the purchaser.

To keep this guarantee valid, the puppy must be examined by a licensed veterinarian within 4 days (excluding Saturday and Sunday) of receipt of the puppy. If the veterinarian finds the puppy unhealthy, unfit, or unsound in any way, the puppy must be returned to the breeder, accompanied by a certificate or statement from the vet. The seller assumes no responsibility for charges incurred by the purchaser for this service. The seller will refund the purchaser the full purchase price or give the purchaser a replacement puppy of equal value if the purchaser so chooses. The purchaser may choose to book another puppy from a later litter if there is none available at the time.

The breeder does not assume any liability or responsibility for any contagious diseases after 3 days from the day the dog is removed from the breeder's premises. Follow your breeder's and veterinarian's advice and do not put your puppy at risk until the puppy is fully immunized.

Any returned puppy must be accompanied by any paperwork supplied by seller (receipt, CKC papers, etc.)

Purchaser must provide all required immunizations from time of purchase. Puppy must have all puppy boosters recommended by their veterinarian after leaving the premises. Puppies must also have rabies when recommended by their veterinarian and then a booster with their rabies each year if it is recommended by their vet. Any parasites, internal or external, must be promptly eliminated.

Clean, fresh water and proper food, in sufficient amounts must be provided. Puppy must be kept clean warm and dry. Puppy may not be allowed out, unattended unless within a secure enclosure.

Purchaser agrees to provide veterinarian care when needed.

Puppy is purchased as a "pet". The puppy must not be used for breeding purposes (accidental or intentional) or the purchaser must pay the breeder the sum of \$7,000.00 (seven thousand dollars) each breeding.

Puppy is purchased on a NON BREEDING contract with the CKC and must be spayed or neutered by the age of 18 months, not sooner than 9 months. Proof of spay or neuter from a veterinarian must be supplied to the breeder by the age of 18 months.

However, if puppy has been sold with breeding/showing rights, there is no guarantee that said puppy will be able to be used for breeding or be of show quality when mature.

Conditional One Year Health Guarantee

Puppy is guaranteed for 1 year from birth against fatal and/or life threatening genetic/hereditary defects. If this does happen I will replace your puppy with a puppy of equal value when available. Replacement puppy will be agreed upon by both seller and buyer and no money will be refunded in part or whole.

If puppy does die within 1 year, replacement will be given only if buyer has a necropsy done and it is determined by both buyer and seller's veterinarians that pup died from a hereditary problem and not from neglect or abuse. My vet must receive copies of any test results and xrays. If test results/xrays are not provided no replacement shall be given.

- 1) Purchaser agrees to purchase pet insurance on the above described dog for a minimum period of 1 year.
- 2) **Heart, Kidney & Liver:** If the dog dies from an inherited condition affecting the heart, kidney or liver the breeder will replace the puppy from the first available litter free of charge. This is determined by autopsy and results must be agreed upon by both the breeder's vet and the purchaser's veterinarian at the purchaser's expense.

- 3) **Hip Dysplasia:** If the dog develops hip dysplasia, grade 4 or over that requires surgery, the breeder will pay the deductible on the pet insurance (up to \$500).
- 4) **Eye:** Issues with eyes due to eyelashes or eye lids such as entropion are the responsibility of the purchaser as well as "cherry eye".
- 5) **Skin:** All dogs carry a parasite known as demodex or demodectic mange. Not all dogs end up suffering from it. It can be brought about by stress or new environments. This is the responsibility of the purchaser.
- 6) Both parties agree that the health guarantee is VOID if the puppy is found to be either overweight or underweight.

Common parasites such as fleas, ticks, worms, coccidia, Guardia, kennel cough are not covered.

Cherry eye, loose hips, skin allergies, elongated soft palette, tight nares, undescended testicles, thyroid dysfunction, loose knees and autoimmune disorders are not covered. These are all very common in the breed.

This guarantee only applies to the original buyer and is non-transferable.

If at any time in the puppy's life you decide not to keep him/her, the purchaser will inform me and give me first opportunity to take the dog back or find a suitable home for it. The puppy can not be resold to anyone. Purchase agreement is non-transferrable.

Return Policy: If for any reason this puppy is returned to the breeder within one week of the date of pick up or delivery the breeder will not refund the standing deposit amount of \$500. If the dog is returned after one month the buy back (first right of refusal) will come into effect. Breeder has the first right of refusal if the purchaser cannot keep or take care of this dog. This dog must NOT be sold or given away. Purchase price back to the breeder will be as follows: up to 1 year old \$500; 1 to 2 years old \$300, 2 to 3 years old \$200; over 3 years old \$100.

It takes a lot of patience and love to raise a well-balanced puppy, it is recommended that you crate train your dog. Your puppy might cry the first few nights, this is only because he/she is away from it's litter mates and is scared. This part of puppy parenthood should be handled in a loving manner, eventually your puppy will get used to you and it's new home.
